Required Materials for all students:

Notice of tests or quizzes will usually be given one week in advance. If you are absent on the day of a test/quiz/class work deadline, you must complete it during the next class or after school. Failure on your part to make up the work will result in a zero.

HOMEWORK POLICY

Homework assignments may vary from several thumbnail sketches, visuals, to a typed critical method essay. The average assignment will be graded accordingly:

TURNED IN ON DUE DATE: FULL CREDIT

TURNED IN 1 DAY LATE: 85% TURNED IN 2 DAYS LATE: 65% TURNED IN 3 OR MORE DAYS: 0%

Quarterly Assessments or Performance Assessments: 15%

Performance Assessments may also be graded as Class Assessments or Learning Activities depending on their complexity.

Student Responsibilities & Class Rules
